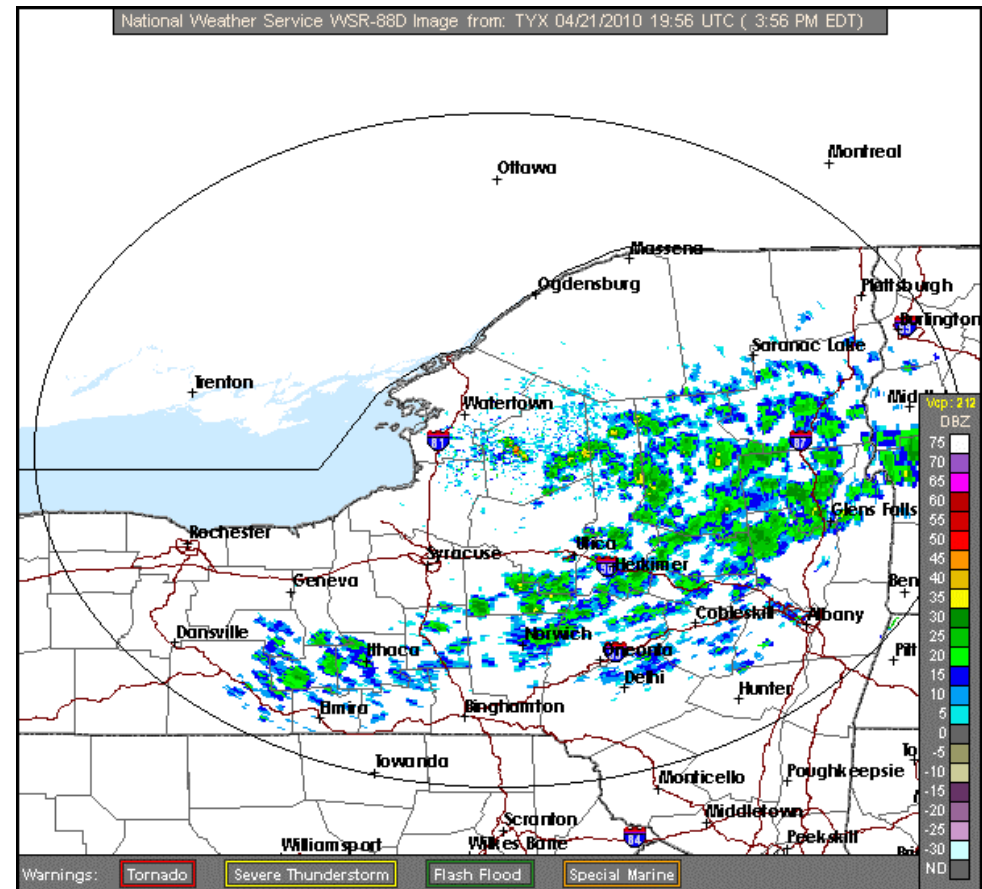
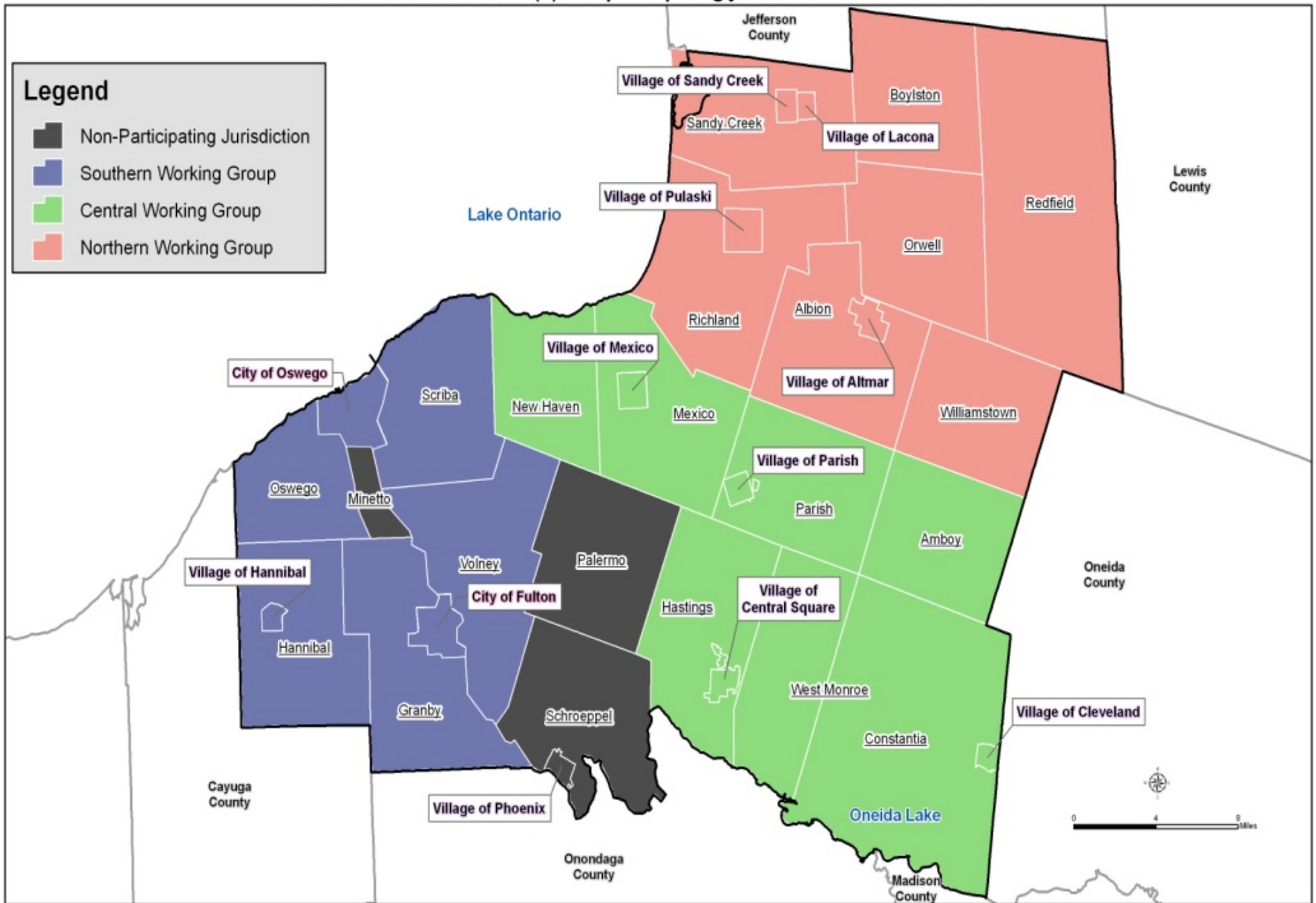


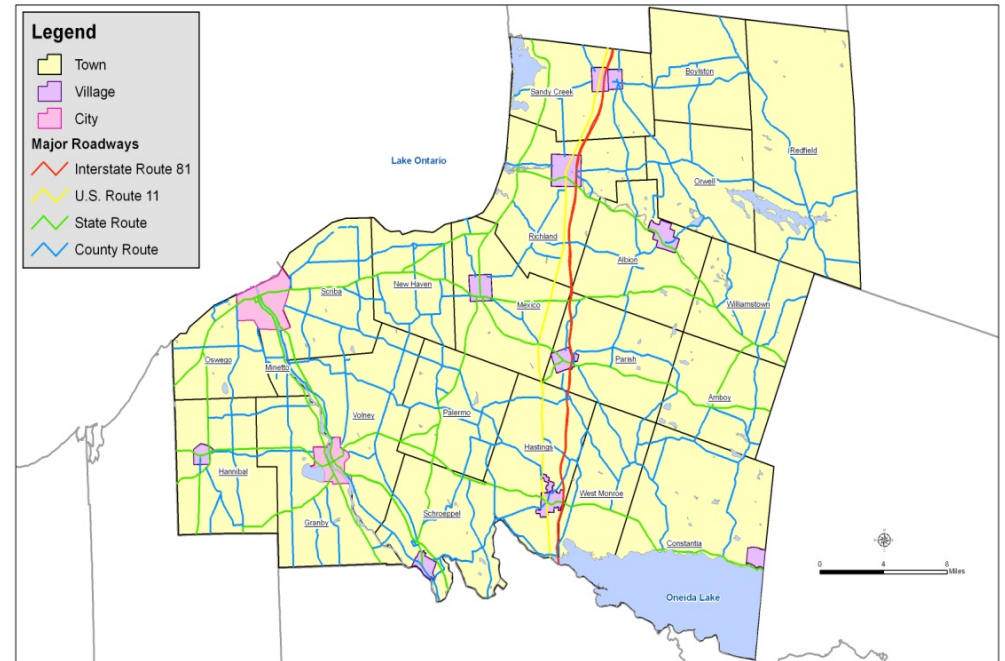
Figure 1.2 - This figure depicts the jurisdictions included in each of the three geographical working groups. The locations of the four (4) non-participating jurisdictions are also shown.

Figure 2.13 - Major Roadways Located Within Oswego County



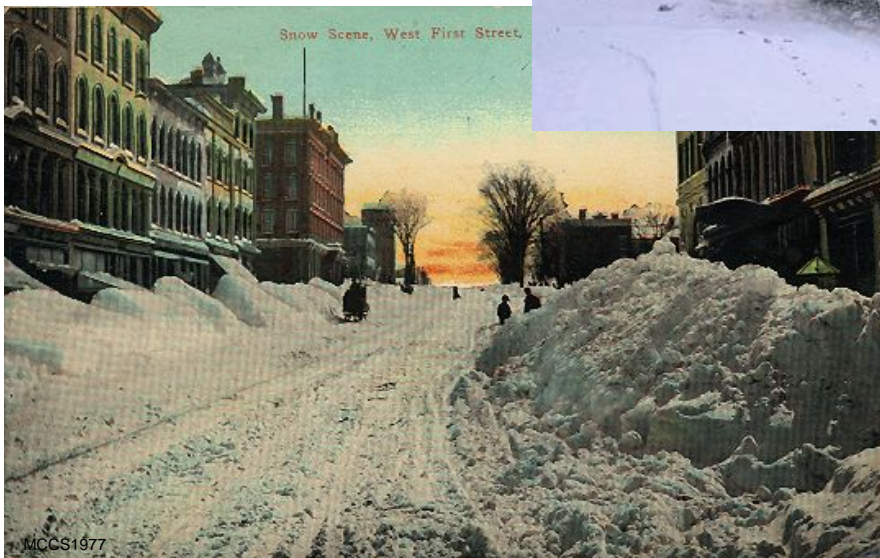
