Notice of Violations

Adolescent Tobacco-Use Prevention Act

The Oswego County Health Department Enforcement Officer is responsible for enforcement of the Adolescent Tobacco-Use Prevention Act (Article 13F of the New York State Public Health Law). This Act prohibits the sale of all tobacco products to persons under 18 years of age. Effective September 1, 2000, New York State law requires public notification of violators.

The following vendors were found to have violated the Adolescent Tobacco-Use Prevention Act in 2011 for selling tobacco products to a minor.

- All In One Pit Stop, 432 Rathburn Road, Fulton
4/20/11, First Offense, \$300 fine
